





January - Annie's Block

12.5" x 12.5"


Annie's Block is a traditional block that uses half-square triangles (HST). Sixteen HSTs are created by using the 8 at a time method below. You will need a fat quarter of 2 different fabrics to create this block.



1. Cut (2) squares each from your fabrics measuring 8.25" x 8.25".
2. Place one fabric square on top of the other fabric square, to make 2 pairs of squares.
3. Trace diagonal lines from each corner on the top square to make an "x" on your square.
4. Sew 1/4" from the line on both sides of the line. Repeat for the other line.
5. Cut the square with 4 cuts. One through each of the lines you made for the "x", one through the middle of the square horizontally, and one through the middle of the square vertically.
6. Press each of your HSTs open. Trim to 3.5" x 3.5"
7. Arrange in the pattern shown.
8. Sew the (4) squares in the first row together. Repeat for Rows 2-4.
9. Press the seams on each row all in the same direction.
10. Starting with Rows 1-2, sew the rows together to complete quilt block.




Sewing Lines




Cutting Lines
