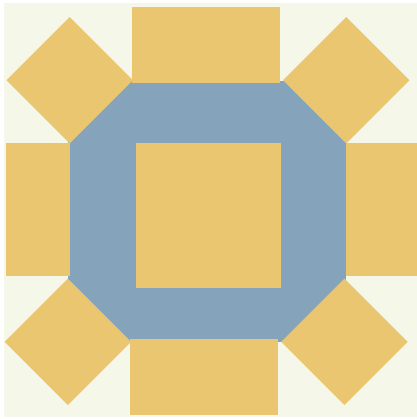




Broken Wheel Quilt Block

12.5" x 12.5"

Directions by Bess of Side Lake Stitch



Fabric A - Cut: 2.5" x 18", 4.5" x 4.5", (4) 3 5/8" x 3 5/8"



Fabric B - Cut: (6) 3.25" x 3.25"



Fabric C - Cut: 2.5" x 18", (2) 3.25" x 3.25"

1. The four corners of this block are a square in a square with a slightly different fabric arrangement - one corner of the outside square is a different color from the other three. Start by cutting the Fabric B and C squares in half diagonally. Place the raw diagonal seam of 2 Fabric B triangles on opposite sides of a Fabric A square. Sew and press. Place a Fabric B and fabric C diagonal on the remaining sides (as shown). Sew and press. Make 3 more squares like this.



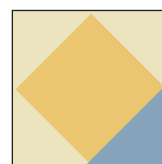
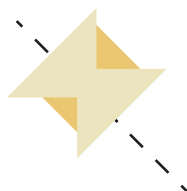

2. Sew your long yellow rectangle and blue rectangle together on the long seam with right sides together. Press. Trim to 4 equal pieces measuring 4.5" x 4.5"



3. Arrange your blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks together in each row. Sew the rows together. Your block will measure 12.5" x 12.5".
