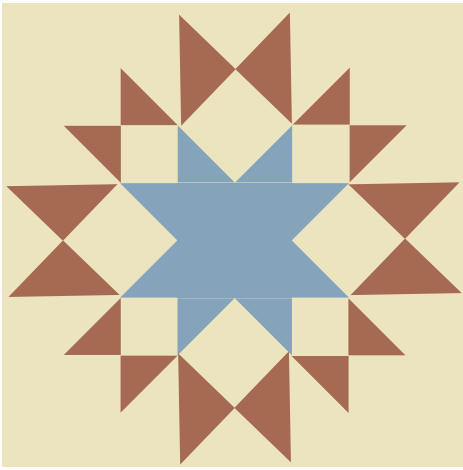




Green Mountain Star Quilt Block

12.5" x 12.5"

Directions by Bess of Side Lake Stitch



Fabric A - Cut: 5.5" x 5.5", (2) 4.5" x 4.5"

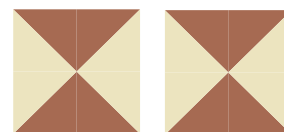
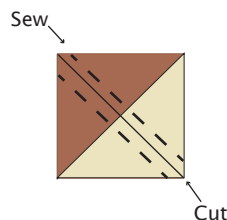
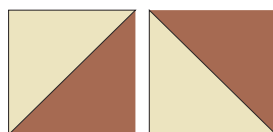
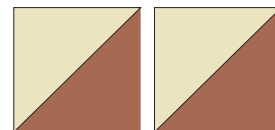
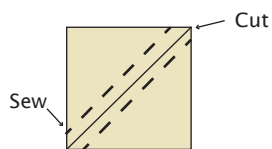
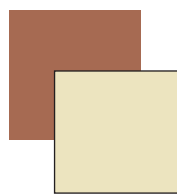


Fabric B - Cut: (2) 5.5" x 5.5", (12) 2" x 2", 3.5" x 3.5", (2) 4.5" x 4.5"

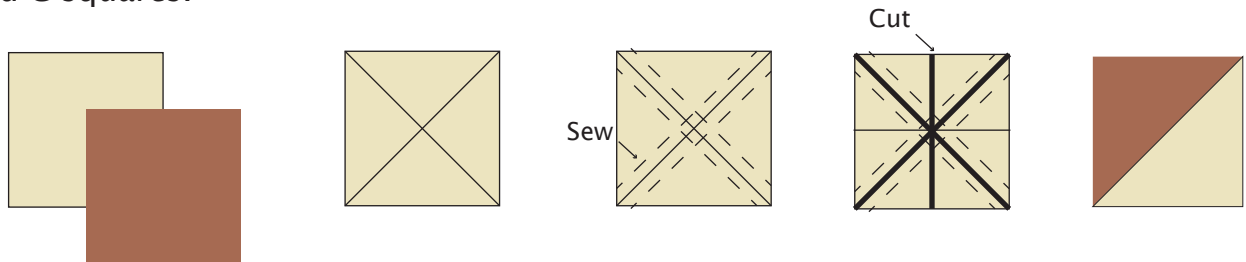


Fabric C - Cut: 3.5" x 3.5", 5.5" x 5.5"

1. Use the 4.5" squares to make half square triangles (HSTs). Place one square on top of the other with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the top square. Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press open to make (2) HSTs. Turn one of the HSTs (as shown). Flip on top of the other HST with right sides together. The Fabric A triangle should be covering the Fabric B triangle below. The seams should be perfectly aligned. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the top square that is opposite of the seam (as shown). Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press to make (2) quarter square triangles (QSTs) that measure 3.5" x 3.5".
2. Repeat step (1) with your other pair of 4.5" squares. You will have 4 QSTs.



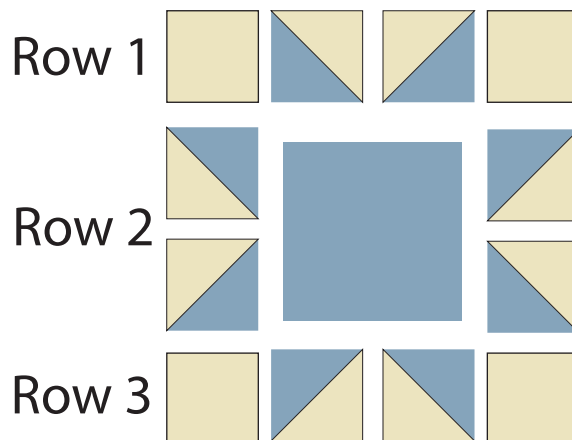
3. Make HSTs. Use the 8-at-a-time method to make 8 HSTs measuring 2" x 2". Place the 5.5" Fabric A square on top of the Fabric B square. Draw two diagonal lines on the backside of the square. sew 1/4" from the line on both sides. Cut along both diagonal lines and in the middle of the square vertically and horizontally. Press the HSTs open and trim to 2" x 2". You will have 8 HSTs. Repeat with the 5.5" Fabric B and C squares.



4. All of the fabric A and Fabric B HSTs will be sewn to a 2" x 2" Fabric B square. The orientation of the HST is important. You will sew 4 of each set shown below.



5. Lay out all of the blocks for the sawtooth star. Sew the blocks in Row 1 together. Sew the blocks in Row 4 together. Sew the HSTs together on each side of the square and then sew the blocks in Row 2 together.



6. Lay out all blocks as shown in the image below. Start by sewing all of your HST/2" square strips onto each side of the QSTs. Next, sew the pieces in each row together. Sew the rows together. Your block should measure 12.5" x 12.5".
