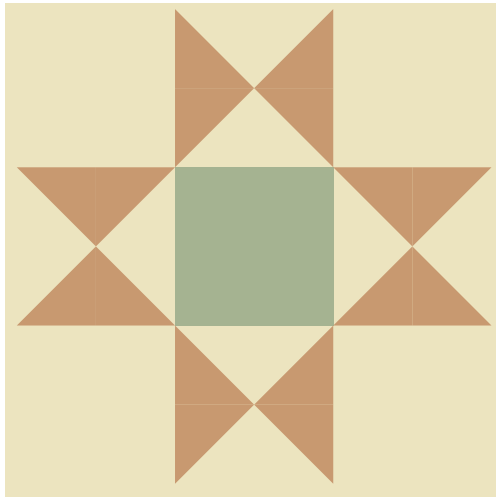




Ohio Star Quilt Block

Directions by Bess Casey Wilke of Side Lake Stitch



Fabric A - Cut: (1) 4.5" x 4.5"

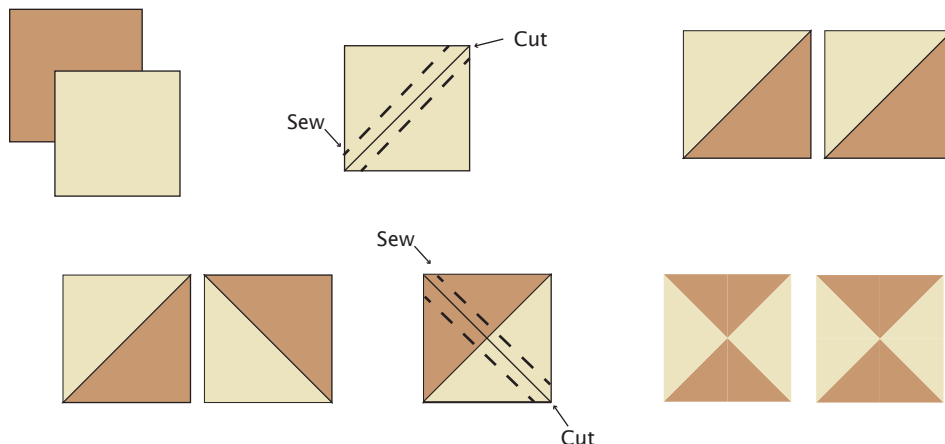


Fabric B - Cut: (4) 4.5" x 4.5"; (2) 5.5" x 5.5"



Fabric C - Cut: (2) 5.5" x 5.5"

1. Use the 5.5" squares to make half square triangles (HSTs). Place one square on top of the other with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the top square. Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press open to make (2) HSTs. Turn one of the HSTs (as shown). Flip on top of the other HST with right sides together. The Fabric C triangle should be covering the Fabric B triangle below. The seams should be perfectly aligned. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the top square that is opposite of the seam (as shown). Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press to make (2) quarter square triangles (QSTs).
2. Repeat step (1) with your other pair of 5.5" squares.



3. Align the squares as shown. Sew the blocks in each row together to create three rows. Press seams. Sew the rows together to create your finished block, measuring 12.5" x 12.5".
