



# Honeymoon Quilt Block

Directions by Bess of Side Lake Stitch




-  Cut: (1) 4.5" x 4.5"; (4) 2.5" x 2.5"
-  Cut: (4) 5.5" x 5.5"
-  Cut: (1) 6.25" x 6.25"
-  Cut: (1) 6.25" x 6.25", (4) 5.5" x 5.5", (4) 2.5" x 2.5"

1. Make quarter square triangles (QSTs) using the 5.5" squares from fabric B and background fabric. First, make half square triangles (HSTs). Place a background fabric directly on top of the fabric B square with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of the square. Sew 1/4" away from the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line and press the HSTs open.
2. Align the two HSTs with one on top of the other, right sides together. The diagonal seam should be aligned and opposite fabrics touching should be on top of one another. Draw a diagonal line across the back of the HST that is the opposite direction from the seam of the HSTs. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press QSTs open. Trim to 4.5" x 4.5". Repeat with the three other pairs to make a total of 4 QSTs.




Align on top with

3. Make HSTs. Use the 8-at-a-time method to make 8 HSTs measuring 2.5" x 2.5". Place the 6.25" background square on top of the Fabric C square. Draw two diagonal lines on the backside of the square. sew 1/4" from the line on both sides. Cut along both diagonal lines and in the middle of the square vertically and horizontally. Press the HSTs open and trim to 2.5" x 2.5". You will have 8 HSTs.



4. Piece together each of the four corner squares. Using the diagram below, sew the background square and HST together in the top row with right sides together. Sew the HST and Fabric A square together for the bottom row. Press seams. Sew the rows together, matching seams. Repeat to make 4 identical corner blocks. The blocks will be rotated for each corner.



5. Arrange the block as shown in the diagram below. Sew the pieces in each row together. Press seams. Sew each row together to create the finished block. The block should measure 12.5" x 12.5".
